For our [*Confirmation class and/or Youth Group session*] on [*date*], a group from Project LIFEtalk will be coming in to speak to the candidates / youth about the horrors of abortion and to encourage the culture of life. At that time, the candidates/youth will have an opportunity to view a short video entitled “The Victims of Choice.” Although the video itself is not rated, portions of it graphically and honestly depict the result of the abortion procedure, and may be difficult for more sensitive viewers to watch.

While we believe this is a wonderful opportunity to learn the truth about abortion, we recognize that you may not feel comfortable having your child watch it. We hope that you will discuss this with your child and decide that you would like him or her to watch the video. If you prefer that your child not view it, we will respect your wishes and he or she will go to another room while the 3 minute video is being shown. Please let us know by [*date prior to presentation*], if you do not want your child viewing the video.

An average 3,300 abortions are performed *each day* in our nation. As American Christians, we are responsible for learning the truth of what abortion is and how it affects the mother, the unborn child, and our society. In order to defend the lives of the unborn, we must be as educated as possible about the horrors of abortion.

We also invite you to come to the presentation with your child and view the video together. This is an opportunity to learn with your child about how to help create a culture of *life!*
